



# COURSE CARE & GUIDELINES

<p><b>PACE OF PLAY</b></p>	<p><b>9 Holes:</b> 2 Hours &amp; 15 Minutes  <b>18 Holes:</b> 4 Hours &amp; 30 Minutes</p>
<p><b>BALL MARKS</b></p>	<p>Please repair your ball mark immediately by pushing (not pulling) the turf gently toward the center of the ball mark &amp; smoothing the surface with your putter encouraging turf recovery &amp; a smooth playing surface.</p> <div data-bbox="480 525 1484 1050"> <p><b>How To Repair a Ball Mark</b>  <small>A few extra seconds is all it takes to keep the putting greens looking and playing their best.</small></p> <p><b>USGA</b></p> <p><b>CHOOSE WISELY</b>  <small>A ball mark repair tool is recommended, but other pointed devices can be used.</small></p> <p><b>PUSH DON'T PRY</b>  <small>Starting from the back and sides, gently push &amp; stretch the turf to the center of the mark.</small></p> <p><b>WORK AROUND</b>  <small>Work around the ball mark until it's filled in. Avoid lifting &amp; twisting the turf harshly.</small></p> <p><b>FINAL TOUCH</b>  <small>Use your putter to lightly tap down the mark. Fix other marks in addition to yours.</small></p> </div>
<p><b>DIVOTS</b></p>	<p>Please replace all divots wherever possible and press them firmly back into place to level the surface and encourage turf recovery.</p>
<p><b>GOLF CARTS</b></p>	<p>Please follow all signage, ropes and staff direction at all times. Even with a handicap flag, golf carts must remain at least:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 30 feet away from putting green surfaces</li> <li>• 15 feet away from teeing areas</li> <li>• Avoid any wet or thin area whenever possible</li> </ul>
<p><b>BUNKERS</b></p>	<p>Please be sure to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enter and exit bunkers from the lowest point</li> <li>• Rake and smooth your strike mark and your footprints</li> <li>• Leave rake on outside edge of bunk when finished</li> </ul>
<p><b>STAFF SAFETY</b></p>	<p>Please ensure staff members see you before hitting in their direction and allow them appropriate time to move safely.</p>
<p><b>OVERALL COURSE CARE</b></p>	<p>Please help keep the course in excellent condition by properly disposing of trash, removing broken tees, and respecting the signage and staff direction throughout the property.</p>
